FAQs

What are the clinic's hours?

Kids First Pediatrics is open Monday-Thursday from 8AM-5PM and Friday from 8 AM-2PM.

Do you do walk-in hours?

We are not a walk-in clinic. However we will do our best to accommodate urgent needs. Unless medically urgent, patients who walk in may have to wait until scheduled patients are seen.

Do you take unvaccinated children?

Kids First Pediatrics recommends all routine pediatric vaccines be given as recommended by the AAP and ACIP. We do not delay or space vaccinations unless specifically indicated. Although we support a parents' right to make decisions for their children, we have developed our policy in order to best protect those patients of ours who are most medically vulnerable.

What if I have questions at night or on the weekends or holidays?

Sometimes, injuries and illnesses don't happen during normal business hours. If you are unsure whether or not you need to bring your child to the emergency room, please call and we will help talk you through the next best step. If your child is having a medical or psychiatric emergency, please call 911.

We are happy to help with routine medical questions, however, we request that these questions be sent through the portal or during normal business hours. Medication refills and appointment requests cannot be done after hours.

Am I going to see a different doctor every time I come in?

As a patient of Kids First Pediatrics, you will always see your doctor. Kids First Pediatrics is owned and operated by Dr. Jenny Seawell, and there are no other doctors or nurse practitioners working in the clinic. As such, all medical appointments will be scheduled with Dr. Seawell. In the event that an alternative provider is covering the clinic, this WILL be communicated to all scheduled patients and you will have the opportunity to reschedule if so desired.

Do I have to wear a mask while in the clinic?

Masks are required for all over 2 years of age in the clinic. We are happy to provide you with a mask if you do not have one. We don't love them either and hope to one day not need them. On the bright side, masks also cut down on transmission of colds and flu so you are MUCH less likely to get sick coming to the doctor!

Is there a separate sick and well waiting room?

Kids First Pediatrics has a single waiting room that is for well children. If you or your child is ill, we request that you wait in your vehicle while we get you checked in. Once ready, we will bring you directly to an exam room where you will be more comfortable. We understand that no-one feels like being at the doctor when sick and it is our goal to get you taken care of efficiently and then back to the comfort of your own home.
